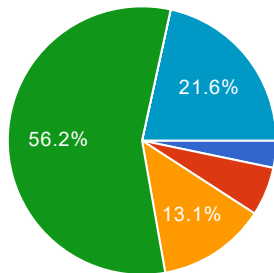

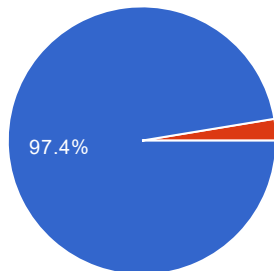


Which of the following best describes how you currently dispose of the grease that is leftover after cooking a meal:



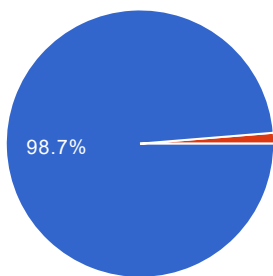

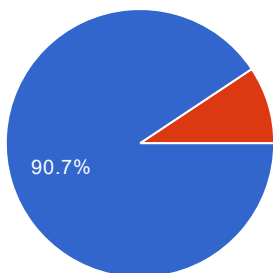

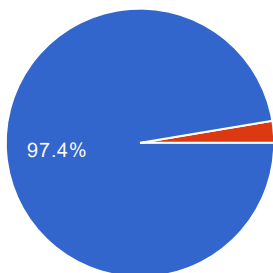

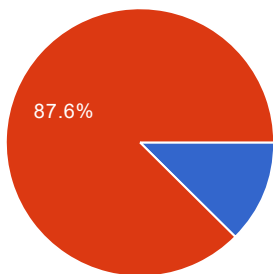

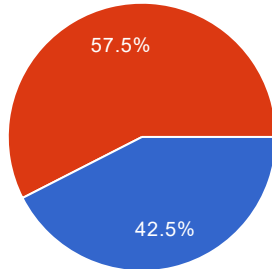
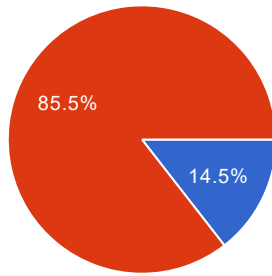
Do you have children under the age of 3 in the house?

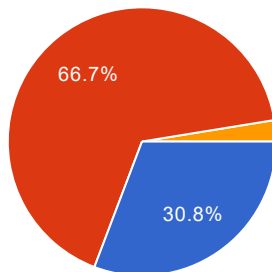

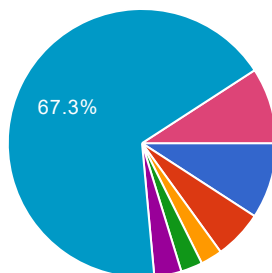

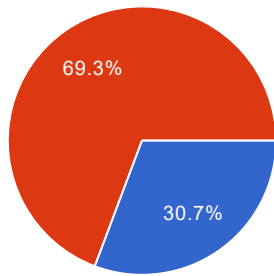

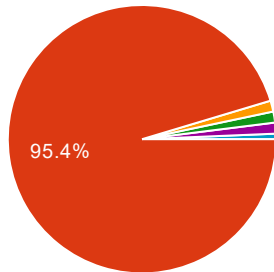
